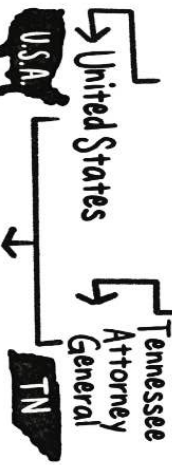

U.S. versus Skremetti



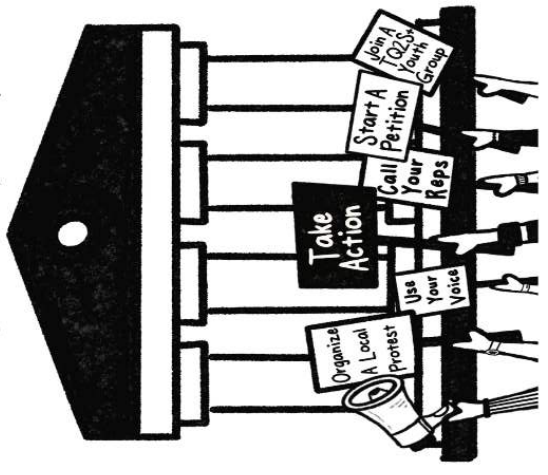
Argument over Tennessee law banning gender affirming medical care for trans youth



TN law violates the Equal Protection Clause of the 14th Amendment and discriminates against minors seeking drugs for trans youth based on gender identity "other medical purposes"

Suing TN on behalf of Samantha and Brian Williams and their 15 year old trans daughter, two other families filing anonymously, and medical doctor Dr. Lucy

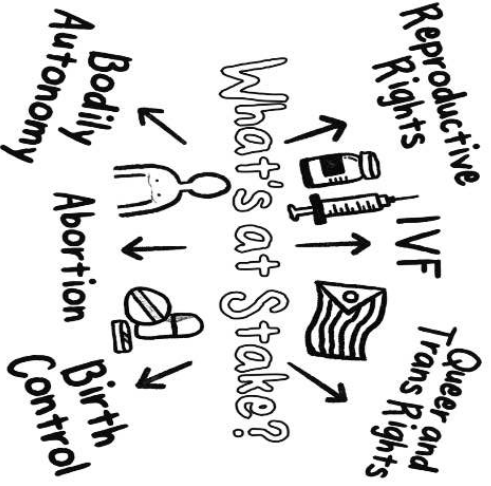

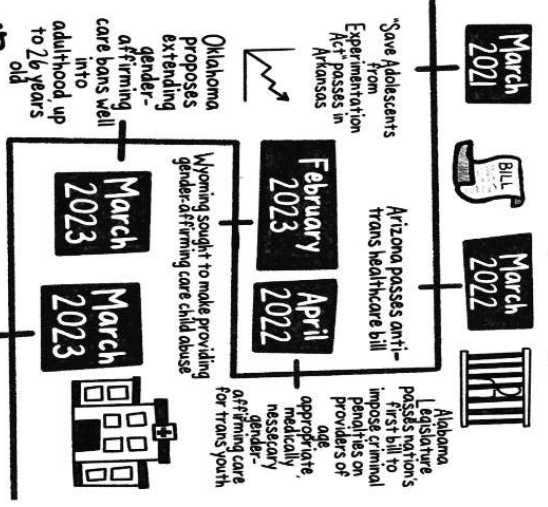

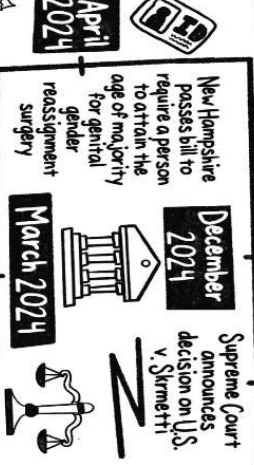
"I want this law to be struck down so that I can continue to receive the care I need, in conversation with my parents and my doctors, and have the freedom to live my life and do the things I enjoy."

Today

Today more than three-quarters of trans youth live in states that have introduced bans on their medical care, and more than one-third of trans youth live in states where these bans have been enacted.
